

**Sign this Confidential ASU Petition in favour of a
Multi-Employer Enterprise Agreement for your workplace in the
Social and Community Services Sector**

THIS IS BIGGER THAN ONE WORKPLACE

The Australian Services Union is pursuing a multi-employer enterprise agreement ('MEA') across the social and community services sector.

An MEA is an enterprise agreement that covers multiple employers across the same industry or sector.

Instead of negotiating separate agreements, workplace by workplace, an MEA allows workers and employers to come together to bargain collectively.

How do we do this?

1. Collect confidential petition signatures to identify where members are interested in pursuing a multi-employer agreement (once endorsed, delegates to discuss with management if they would consent);
2. Get endorsement from members to pursue this at your workplace; and
3. Collect confidential petition signatures from staff and members (Yes, members have to do it again!), to reach at least a 50% +1 of all staff wanting to be party to a multi-employer agreement.



This bargaining process is not just about your workplace

- We are pursuing a multi-employer agreement, creating an opportunity to **establish stronger standards across the community and social services sector**.
- The outcomes achieved through this process have the potential to **influence conditions well beyond** a single organisation.
- This is about creating **lasting improvements** that can support workers **across the sector** for years to come.
- The stronger our membership, the stronger our voice in **shaping** those outcomes.

Membership Makes the Difference

- Members determine bargaining priorities.
- Members vote on key decisions.
- Members receive representation, advice, and support throughout the process.
- Members are the collective force that gives bargaining power and legitimacy.
