Why is the Australian Services Union (ASU) pursuing a multi-employer agreement for social and community services (SACS) sector?

- The strength of ASU members across multiple organisations increase our bargaining power to achieve better outcomes
- Establish consistent wages and conditions across the sector
- This is the only opportunity that allows us to force funders (Government) to the bargaining table and highlight the demand for increased funding and support

Why YOU should sign this petition:

- An enterprise agreement protects and improves conditions into the future. This prevents employers from offering reduced wages and benefits, so they remain competitive
- This is one of the most effective ways to combat the "race to the bottom" that's been plaguing the sector for years – when multiple organisations are on the same enterprise agreement, no one organisation can undercut the other to win a tender
- Forces the Government to fund services based on the true cost of delivering quality care with a properly compensated workforce, rather than exploiting wage gaps between organisations
- Stops the frustrating cycle where one workplace trains a fantastic worker, only for them to be poached by a partner agency offering a slightly higher wage under a different EBA. Everyone grows together
